



COVID-19 Protocols and Considerations

If you are showing symptoms of COVID-19 or live with someone who has COVID-19, please do not travel or make the trip to Port McNeill. Call your doctor, or the local public health office. If in BC, you may call 8-1-1. Anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19 will not be permitted to participate in the kayak trip. If you do not feel well, please stay home.

Physical distancing is required at all times (minimum of 2 metres) between guests and Kingfisher staff. No handshaking, or hugging etc. Physical distancing is not required between guests who are family or close friends. Failure to observe physical distancing guidelines risks ending the trip and the closure of our operation.

Kingfisher will be providing sufficient cleaning and sanitizing products while on trip. For an added measure please bring your own personal sanitizer to use each and every time you touch a shared surface while in transit and/or around camp (vehicle interiors, dining areas, etc.).

Following the recommendations of Health Canada, we require all clients to wear a mask or face covering whenever unable to maintain physical distance of 2 metres. This will be in vehicles and water taxis but may be required in other circumstances as well. Please bring your own masks/face coverings.

You will be assigned your own equipment for the duration of the trip including paddling jackets, PFDs, dry bags, spray skirts, and paddles. Please do not handle other people's equipment. In the case of shared equipment, your guides will be responsible for managing their use and disinfecting between uses and/or enacting glove protocol.

Pre-Screening Questions

Please answer the following questions:

1. Do you currently have any of the following new or worsening symptoms?
 - Fever (temperature greater than 37°C)
 - Cough
 - Fatigue
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Muscle aches and pains
 - Stuffy or runny nose
 - Sore throat
 - Loss of taste or smell
2. Have you been in contact with someone with a probable or confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

3. Have you travelled outside of Canada or been in contact with someone who has in the past 14 days?

4. Are you currently under mandatory quarantine, as a result of recent travel or by orders from the provincial, territorial or local public health authorities?
